<p><b>COMMENTS:</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fort McMurray bylaw does not allow for passenger pick-up/drop-off in locations other than designated bus stops.</li> <li>• Coaches will travel exclusively on roads designed to accommodate large vehicles, and stop at locations designed and signed for safe passenger loading/unloading - both items will decrease the risk of incidents.</li> <li>• Fort McMurray has committed to the rehabilitation of existing bus shelters and installation of approximately 150 heated shelters. This work will be completed before the end of the year.</li> <li>• There is a bus stop within 400 meters of the majority of homes in Fort McMurray.</li> <li>• Coach drivers will drop off passengers at <b>bus stops only</b>; please do not ask drivers to stop anywhere except at your bus stop. If you fail to get off the bus at your preferred stop, you will need to ride to the next stop.</li> <li>• Bus route start times have not changed. But, because there are fewer stops, your route <i>may</i> take less time. Be at your bus stop a few minutes earlier than usual, especially for the first few days, to be sure you are on time. Start and route times will be re-evaluated once the new system has been running for a while.</li> <li>• Passengers can start using designated bus stops immediately, there's no need to wait until September 10.</li> <li>• All Oil Sand and Industry bussing programs will also use designated bus stops only.</li> <li>• Fort McMurray will continue to grow their program by reviewing road use, and adding bus stops when and where appropriate.</li> </ul>
